This day is celebrated all our the country to commemorate birth anniversary of the greatest engineer Sir M. Visvesvaraya, Bharat Ratna. On this occasion Jenab Taj Mohi-Ud-Din, Hon'ble Minister for PHE, Irrigation & Flood Control, Government of Jammu & Kashmir was the Chief Guest.

Rich tributes to Sir M. Visvesvaraya were paid by Er. S. K. Raina, FIE, Executive Director, Chenab Valley Power Projects Pvt. Limited in which he highlighted his qualities like Austerity, Integrity, Competence and Discipline.

Earlier, **Er. Braj Bhushan Sharma**, **FIE**, **Chairman** of the Jammu Centre presented the *Welcome Address*. He highlighted different problems being faced by engineers which interalia included unemployment, stagnation and deprivation of time bound promotions. He advocated for time bound promotions for engineers, removal of structural anomalies in engineering services of J&K and jobs to unemployed engineers and requested the Chief Guest to take up these issues with the Govt. for mitigation of engineers' grievances.

On this occasion, the Chief Guest presented R. L. Sharma Memorial Gold Medal and Rudra Bhagwati Silver Medal to Er. B. L. ## MEMBERS IN THE NEWS



Er. VINOD KHAJURIA, FIE

Er. Vinod Khajuria, FIE has taken over as Chief Engineer, Commercial and Survey Wing, Power **Development Department** in September, 2012.

He is an alumni of Regional Engineering College (Now NIT), Kurushetra and passed out in 1976. He started his career as Supervisor in Salal Hydro Electric Project, Jyotipuram in 1976 and switched over to J&K Govt. Services by joining Power Development Department in 1977. Later, he remained on deputation to NHPC Ltd. from 1978 to 1981 and was associated with construction of 220KV S/C Sarna-Jammu Transmission Line which was the key line to connect Northern Grid with J&K State at that time. Further, he served in various wings of Power Development Department after his repatriation from NHPC Ltd. in 1981 and rose to the rank of Chief Engineer in 2012. He had a stint in J&K State Power Development Corporation also from 2002 to 2006 and was associated with the construction of prestigious Baglihar Hydroelectric Project, Chanderkot. He was honored with the distinction of representing J&K Govt. in International Conference on transformers i.e. TRANFOTECH-2000 at Mumbai as a delegate from J&K Govt.



Er. Narinder Rohmetra, MIE, took over as Chief Engineer, Swalkote Hydro Electric Project, Ramban in May, 2012. He is an alumni of Regional Engineering College (Now NIT), Srinagar and passed out in 1977.

He started his service career with SICOP, J&K Govt. as Estate Manager in 1977. Later, he switched over to Public Works Department of J&K Govt. & joined as Junior Engineer there. He was promoted as Assistant Engineer in 1983 and Assistant Executive Engineer in 1986 & served in Hydraulic Wing at Jammu & Kathua with a stint in Power Development Department too. He was promoted as Executive Engineer in October, 2004 and served in Public Health Engineering divisions of Udhampur & Kathua where he executed various water supply schemes of both the districts by constructing over head tanks, ground reservoirs, drilling of tube wells and laying of rising main / gravity main / distribution pipe network and filtration plants. Further, he was promoted as Superintending Engineer in the year June, 2007. As Superintending Engineer he served in Hydraulic Circle, Udhampur and later as Project Manager in Economic Reconstruction

Agency of J&K Govt. popularly called ERA. In his stint as SE in ERA he executed 30 MLD Sewage Treatment Plant and laying of sewer in Jammu West comprising of 146 KMs network of main and sewer pipes. Then, he took over as Chief Engineer in Swalkote Hydro Electric Project in May, 2012; which is the biggest Hydel Power Project of J&K Govt. with generation capacity of 1856 MW located at Ramban. He was instrumental in preparation of Detail Project Report for this project under his command as Chief Engineer which comprises of Dam Design, ecological Investigation, Rehabilitation Plan for the persons affected due to compounding of reservoir etc. This report will be ready in Feb., 2013 and tentative cost of this prestigious project is around Rs. 15000 Crores. He has attended a training on Lake Water Quality Management in Japan from January to March, 1996. He has also attended various Workshops/Seminars on Hydrology, Ground Water Management, Trenchless Technology etc. at National Lavel.



Er. Narayan Mengi, FIE has taken over as Chief Engineer, Baglihar Hydroelectric Project of J&K State Power Development Corporation in October, 2012.

He is an alumni of Regional Engineering College (Now NIT), Srinagar and joined J&K Govt. services in 1978 as Junior Engineer. Later, he was promoted as Assistant Engineer through J&K Public Service Commission in 1983. He served as Assistant Engineer / Assistant Executive Engineer in Public Health Engineering / Irrigation & Flood Control Departments at Billawar, Leh, Udhampur & Jammu. Further, he was promoted as Executive Engineer in the year 2004 and Superintending Engineer in the year 2008. He served as SE in Hydraulic Circle / Rawi Tawi Irrigation Construction Circle Jammu & was then transferred to J&K State Power Development Corporation in Feb., 2012. He was promoted as Chief Engineer in October, 2012 and was posted in Baglihar Hydroelectric Project, Chanderkot.



Er. Kishore Kumar Gupta, MIE, has taken over as Chief **Engineer, Irrigation & Flood** Control Department of J&K Govt. at Jammu in October, 2012.

He is an alumni of Thapar Institute of Engineering & Technology, Patiala (Now Thapar University, Patiala) and passed out in 1980. He started his career as an Assistant Engineer in Hydraulic Wing of J&K

Govt. in 1983. He served as Assistant Engineer/Assistant Executive Engineer in various divisions of Hydraulic Wing of J&K Govt. As Executive Engineer, he envisaged and Implemented Water Supply Schemes for augumentation of Water Supply in Kathua & Udhampur towns under UIDSSMT which helped in ensuring portable water supply to public at large. As Superintending Engineer, he was vested with the responsibility of creating the vital artificial lake thorough construction of a barrage on Tawi River at Belicharana which will add to the aesthetic value of Jammu city. He was promoted as Chief Engineer in October, 2012 and has been posted to head Irrigation & Flood Control Department, Jammu.



Er. H. C. Jearth, MIE has taken over as Chief Engineer, Designs, Inspections & Quality **Control Department of J&K** Govt. in Oct., 2012.

He is an alumni of Regional

Engineering College (Now NIT), Srinagar and ioined J&K Govt. Services as Junior Engineer in 1981. Later, he was promoted as Assistant Engineer through J&K Public Service Commission in the year 1983. He served as Assistant Engineer / Assistant Executive Engineer in various divisions of Hydraulic Wing of J&K Govt. Further, he was promoted as Executive Engineer in the year 2004 and was posted in Public Health Engineering Div.-II Jammu and was fully involved in the construction and commissioning of 1.80MGD Filtration Plant at Boria. Later, he was promoted as Superintending Engineer in the year 2009 and was involved in successful implementation of UIDSSMT programmes and other Irrigation and Flood Control works in Kathua & Udhampur Districts. During his stint as Superintending Engineer, Udhampur he got commissioned Water Supply Scheme, PIE Nallah for augumenting drinking water supply at Bhawan and Adh-kuwari of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Temple. He also got executed another prestigious project for augumenting drinking water supply in Katra town under Special Task Force during his stint at Udhampur. He was promoted as Chief Engineer in October, 2012 and was posted in Designs, Inspections and Quality Control Department of J&K Govt. as Chief Engineer. He is overseeing major assignments of formulation of new Sanctioned Schedule of Rates as per prevailing market rates and revamping the Material Testing Laboratories at Jammu & Srinagar during his present stint as Chief Engineer.

## AMIE SECTION – A [ WINTER SESSION ] EXAMINATIONS HELD


