IEI celebrates World Environment Day - 2014

The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Local Centre celebrated **World Environment Day** in its auditorium at Channi Himmat, Jammu. A seminar on the theme topic "Small Islands and Climate Change" with the slogan "Raise you voice not the Sea level" was organized in which large number of engineers, environment lovers, academicians and members of the civil society participated.

On this occasion **Dr. C. M. Seth, Chairperson, WWF-India, J&K State** was the *Chief Guest* and **Dr. Raj Kumar Rampal**, Head, Department of Environmental Sciences, University of Jammu was the *Guest of Honour*. **Er. Braj Bhushan Sharma, FIE;** Immediate Past Chairman of Jammu Local Centre presided over the function.

At the outset, Er. Anil Verma, MIE; Former Honorary Secretary of Jammu Local Centre read the message of Sh. Vinod Ranjan, IFS; Chairman, J&K State Pollution Control Board on World Environment Day, who could not attend the function due to his preoccupation in New Delhi. He appreciated the efforts of Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Local Centre in creating awareness in the society regarding Environmental conservation by organizing such seminars every year in the past also. Er. H. C. Jerath, FIE; Er. B. L. Rawal, MIE; Er Pooja Sharma, AMIE; Er. Supinder Jeet Singh, AMIE & Er. Rajesh Kumar Angural presented papers on the theme topic.

The speakers lamented the degraded scenario of climate in the present times and suggested some measures to be adopted by all the stake holders so that Environmental degradation can be checked. These included afforestation of barren lands, strict enforcement of laws for deforestation so that proper silviculture is adhered to, pressure on the industrialized nations to reduce the green house gas emissions and adoption of renewable energy options like Solar/Wind Energy. One of the speakers suggested some measures which can be adopted by us daily which will help in reducing the energy loss and save the environment from the ingress of harmful emissions. They also stressed for scientific Water Shed management so that vegetative and green cover on our planet is increased thereby reducing the ill effect of climate change.



Dr. C. M. Seth, Chief Guest appreciated the efforts of The Institution of Engineers (India) for taking keen interest in the environmental issues despite being an engineering body. He expressed his displeasure about non implementation of "Environmental"

Sustainability" which is one of the Millennium Development Goals because of casual attitude of all the stake holders. He proposed construction of check dams on the rivers and rivulets to recharge them in dry seasons to make them environmentally sustainable. He also advocated for giving free hand to the field functionaries of all the departments so that they become sensitive to the issues and prepare realistic reports after going in the field instead of preparing the false reports due to pressure of their superiors. This will go a long way in improving the climate of the region and taking proper action by the stake holders based on factual reports.

Er. Mohinder Singh, MIE; Honorary Secretary conducted the proceedings of the seminar, delivered *Welcome Address* and presented *Vote of Thanks* to the august gathering for making this function a grand success.

Er. Rajinder Singh, Chairman of Jammu Centre passes away

Er. Rajinder Singh, FIE; Chairman of The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Local Centre breathed his last on 9th August, 2014 after a brief illness. He was 67 years old and is survived by his wife and two sons. He originally hailed from Village Gohlar Beerwah, District Budgam in Kashmir valley and presently was settled in Sainik Colony, Jammu.

He was a very bright student and did his Bachelors in Agricultural Engineering from erstwhile Allahabad Agricultural Institute, Naini which is presently known as Allahabad University. Being a meritorious student, he was selected for undergoing M.Tech in Asian Institute of Technology, Bangkok (Thailand). He could not complete this degree due to family compulsions and had to leave it half way.



He joined Agriculture Engineering Department in J&K Govt. Services and rose to the rank of Joint Director, Agriculture Engineering. He retired in the year 2005 from Agriculture Complex, Shalimar, Srinagar.

His contributions to the Agricultural research are praise worthy. He had devised around 25 Nos. Agricultural Implements which are in use by the famers/agriculturists today. Being an outstanding & meticulous engineer, he was awarded a Gold Medal (Republic Day Award) by J&K Govt. for rendering outstanding services to the Govt. of J&K on 26th, January,1998. He also remained as Honorary Joint Secretary of The Institution of Engineers (India), J&K State Centre, Srinagar during the year 1997-98.

His contribution to the J&K Govt., The Institution of Engineers (India) and the civil society is highly commendable. He also remained as Member of the J&K Senior Citizens Welfare Council, Jammu and Member of Kashmir Sikh Sangat, Jammu. He had a good aptitude towards writing and remained as editor of Dehat Sandesh, a news paper being published by Northline Group of News papers. He also remained on the Editorial Board of the Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Local Centre since the year 2007 till his death for publication of quarterly mouth piece of Jammu Centre popularly called IEI JAMMU NEWS.

His death has been widely mourned by all whom he was associated with. A Condolence Meeting was organized at the Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Local Centre on 11th August, 2014 in which his contribution and services rendered to this Centre were recalled. His nature of being always humane to one and all was fondly remembered. A similar Condolence Meeting was held at The Institution of Engineers (India), J&K State Centre, Srinagar on 12th August, 2014 in which the members present there fondly recalled his professional contribution as an Agriculture Engineer and his distinguished stint in State Centre Srinagar as Honorary Joint Secretary.

This Centre as well as this State has lost a precious gem and a huge void has been created which will not be filled in the times to come. He will be always remembered by the engineering fraternity of this state for his dedicated services and admirable nature. May Almighty grant eternal peace to his noble soul and strength to his family to bear this immense loss.



This Centre is going to be benefitted by virtue of rich and varied experience of Er. Jerath in the engineering arena.


