World Water Day - 2015 celebrated

The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Local Centre celebrated "World Water Day" on 22nd March, 2015 at Institutional Complex, Channi Himmat, Jammu by holding a Seminar on theme topic "Water and Sustainable Development". The seminar was attended by a large number of engineers from various departments and organizations. The seminar was chaired by Mr. Pravez Ahmed Malik, IAS., Secretary to Govt., PHE, Irrigation & Flood Control Department, J&K Govt., Jammu. The function was presided over by Er. H. C. Jerath, FIE; Chairman of The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Local Centre.

At the outset, Er. Hem Chander Jerath, FIE; Chairman of Jammu Centre presented the Welcome Address in which he enlightened the house about this year's theme topic on World Water Day.

Four papers on the theme topic were presented by Er. B. L. Rawal, MIE; Er. Vijay Kumar Sharma, MIE; Er. Supinder Jeet Singh, AMIE and Er. Rajesh Kumar Angural in which they expressed their viewpoint vis-a-vis theme topic.

The speakers emphasized on the judicial use of water and suggested various practices for water conservation and management. It was proposed in the seminar to integrate water and sustainable development on the foundation of social and environmental factors and participation of all the stakeholders in making it a reality. The speakers lamented the shrinking water resources in J&K State in view of indiscriminate cutting of trees and reckless disposal of sewage and domestic wastes in these water resources and excessive use of pesticides and insecticides in their catchment areas. Some other water management techniques which can be adopted by all individuals at home were also suggested by the speakers to conserve this precious resource for mankind in the future times to come.



Er. Mohinder Singh, MIE; Honorary Secretary conducted the proceedings of the seminar and presented the vote of thanks to the august gathering. At the start of the Technical Session, Honorary Secretary stressed upon using water judiciously. He made the audience aware by informing that if wastage of water is not checked, coming years will be very tough for the humanity due to absence of this commodity which will become scarce. In the end, he thanked the press media for coverage of the seminar

Er. Supinder Jeet Singh brings laurels to Jammu Centre

Er. Supinder Jeet Singh, an Associate Member of the Institution of Engineers (India), working as Senior Technical Analyst in the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), Govt. of India actively participated and made commendable contributions for the Grand success of RE-Invest 2015.

RE-Invest 2015 was the first Renewable Energy Global Investors Meet & Expo organized by the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy. Its objective was to showcase the Government of India's commitment to the development and scaling up of renewable energy in India to meet the national energy requirement in a socially, economically and ecologically sustainable manner.

It was the first major platform for investment promotion in this sector as a follow-up to the 'Make in India' initiative launched by the Prime Minister of India to connect the global investment community with renewable energy stakeholders in India. RE-Invest was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Sh. Narendra Modi, and was attended by over 200 investors, 350 exhibitors and 1000 delegates worldwide. RE-Invest was held from 15 - 17 February 2015 in New Delhi, India.

Senior representatives from the renewable energy industry, equipment manufacturers, global financial institutions, Public Sector Enterprises, regulatory authorities, central and state governments, research institutions and academia participated in the 3-day Conference & Expo.

Currently Renewable energy contributes about 6.5% in the electricity mix of the country. It is proposed that this would be taken to about 12% in the next three years. Major initiatives by the Government, including accelerated depreciation, generation based incentive, feed-in-tariff and viability gap funding, are expected to add massive investments in renewable energy sector. FDI up to 100% under the automatic route is permitted in renewable energy sector.

The following commitments were made by Investors to the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India:

- · Power Producers: 217314 MW (Solar: 166246 MW, Wind: 45296 MW, Others: 3685 MW)
- · Manufacturing: 41550 MW (Solar: 5050 MW, Wind: 36350 MW)
- EPC: 6000 MW
- Financing: 11500 MW
- Non-Power Generation: 3 Lakh Ton Bioethanol + 3 Lakh Ton Pellets.

The Valedictory session was addressed by Hon'ble Finance Minister Sh. Arun Jaitely & Hon'ble Minister for Railways Suresh Prabhakar Prabhu and was concluded by Sh. Piyush Goyal, Hon'ble Minister of State with Independent Charge for Power, Coal and New & Renewable Energy with vote of thanks to all Participants and Stake Holders.

This Centre congratulates Er. Supinder Jeet Singh for bringing laurels to this Centre. It will not be out of place to mention here that Er. Supinder Jeet has contributed many papers on various seminars being organized by this Centre from time to time. Pertinently, he has won R. L. Sharma Memorial Gold Medal for presenting the Best Technical Paper during the year 2013 - 14 in this Centre. However, this Gold Medal has not yet been awarded to him because of cancellation of Award function and other celebrations of $47^{\rm th}$ Engineers' Day due to natural calamity which struck our state in the month of September, 2014.
