World Water Day - 2016 celebrated

The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Local Centre celebrated "World Water Day" on 22nd March, 2016 at Institutional Complex, Channi Hilmnat, Jammu by holding a Seminar on the theme topic "Water and Jobs". The seminar was attended by a large number of Engineers, Hydrologists, NGOs, people from various departments, organisations and senior citizens.

On this occasion, Er. H. B. Khajuria, FIE, Former Chief Engineer, PHE & Irrigation Department, J&K Govt., Jammu was Chief Guest and Dr. Pettakkal George Jose, Scientist of Hydrology, Western Himalayana Regional Centre was the Guest of Honour. The function was presided over by Er. Ajay Gupta, FIE; Chairman of The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Local Centre.

07 Nos papers on the theme topic were presented by Er. S. C. Thukral, FIE; Er. P. K. Nanda, MIE; Er. Vijay Kumar Sharma, MIE; Er. Prabhuling Raja, Er. K. R. Suri, Er. Sunil Bhasin, MIE and Mr. Akash Dugotra.

The speakers emphasized on the judicious use of water and suggested various practices for water conservation and management. It was proposed in the seminar to integrate water and sustainable development on the foundation of social, environmental factors and participation of all the stakeholders in making it a reality.



It was also deliberated for having proper utilization of ground water. Provision of solar power arrangements to the farmers was also advocated so that they can have good cash crop. In addition to this it was also proposed by one of the speakers that the pressure on water resources in urban areas can be reduced by shifting the centres of development from urban areas to rural areas. The speakers emphasized that water has the ability to create paid, decent jobs and can contribute to a greener economy and sustainable development.



Er. H. B. Khajuria, FIE in the concluding address highlighted that some Water Management Techniques can be adopted by all individuals like using of waste water for small scale vegetable gardening, pisciculture and other techniques that require less water.

On this occasion Dr. Vinod Sharma, Former Development Commissioner, Town Planning Organisation, Jammu, J&K Govt. presented an interesting power point presentation.

Shri. Vinod Sharma, FIE; Chief Executive Officer, Economic Reconstruction Agency, J&K Govt. & Shri. The presentation focused on the concept, design aspects, financial aspects and the steps that can be taken to make Bahu Plaza more attractive destination for Jammu city residents. It was brought out that the powerful forces including demographics, globalization and rapidly profound life style is bringing about profound changes in the concept of future planning in urban areas. As a result of this while envisaging the upgradation of Jammu city to the level of smart city all the parameters need to be considered before finalizing of the master plan of Jammu city. The shortage of parking slots need to be urgently addressed in the extension schemes. In addition to this it was desired and appealed to the authorities that the existing parking slots be maintained properly and the traffic management system should be adopted to a better way. The law making agencies should act in a more disciplined way. It was also emphasized that the recommendations, during the deliberations and interactive session must be put before the Govt. for involving all stakeholders for the development of Jammu city and Bahu Plaza as a part of it.

Dr. Ajay Gupta, FIE; Chairman IIE Jammu Centre concluded the seminar and highlighted the importance of Bahu Plaza in respect of tourism, commercial aspects and culture aspects for the State.

A Technical Seminar on the position of Power/Energy Scenario was organized at The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Local Centre at Canal Hillmat on 29th January, 2016 in which 62 nos speakers viz., Er. Shafiq Sultan, Chief Executive Officer, Jammu & Kashmir Energy Dev. Agency, Science and Technology Department, J&K Govt. and Er K. R. Suri, Retired General Manager Power Grid Corporation of India and Consultant Services Power Grid Venture. While the former presented his paper on Roof Top Solar Energy, the later presented his paper on Jallandhar-Samba-Amargarh Power Transmission System. Er. D. S. Power, FIE; Former Chief Engineer, PDD & Former Member of J&K Electricity Regulatory Commission was the Chief Guest on this occasion. Er. Ajay Gupta, FIE; Chairman, IEI, Jammu Local Centre presided over the function.
