05 nos. papers on the theme topic were presented by Er. S. C. Thakral, FIE; Er. K. R. Sori, FIE; Er. Ranjasev Sawhney, MIE; Er. Sewa Ram, MIE and Er. Rajesh Kumar Angural.

The speakers emphasized that unsustainable and illegal wild life trade is the second biggest direct threat to species after the destruction of habitat. We all need to work together to conserve our diverse wild life resources for future generations and increase in Wildlife trade is driving towards a broad range of wildlife species for global extinction. There is an urgent need for knowledge and action to bring legal wildlife trade within sustainable levels through strong implementation and enforcement of poorly communicated and implemented laws by the authorities. The political will of the Government and strong Governance and imposition of penalties for legal infringements are the need of the hour.
