The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Centre celebrated World Water Day on 22ndMarch, 2023 at Institutional Complex, Channi Himmat, Jammu by holding a seminar on the theme 'Accelerating the change to solve the water and sanitation crisis', emphasizing the necessity of taking stern action to address the global water crisis. The seminar was attended by a large number of Engineers & Hydrologists from various departments, organizations besides senior engineers.

On this occasion, Sh. Mohinder Angurala, Sr. Hydrogeologist, Central Ground Water Board, Jammu was the Chief Guest and Prof. (Dr.) Bhawna Sharma, Chairman, IEI Jammu Centre presided over the function.

At the outset, Prof. (Dr.) Bhawna Sharma, FIE introduced the theme of World Water Day to the audience. She said that the objective of the seminar is to raise awareness and inspire action to tackle the water and sanitation crisis, thereby achieving the Sustainable Development Goal of Water and Sanitation for all by 2030. She emphasized that to accelerate change, we need more action. Each one of us has to contribute and make one's own action list. All of us can make a difference by changing the way we use, consume and manage water in our lives.

During the seminar, Er. Ajay Sharma, FIE; Er. P. K. Nanda, MIE; Er. B. L. Rawal, MIE; Er. Joy Ganjoo, AM Technologist; Er. Akash Dasgotra, AMIE & Er. Anil Kumar, AMIE also presented their papers on the theme of the World Water Day.

While speaking on the occasion, Sh. Mohinder Angurala said everyone knows that 'Water is the elixir of life' - From drinking to cleaning and other things, life cannot sustain without it. While many people are privileged to have running water 24x7, there is a huge population around the globe that does not have access to any amount of water. According to UN, at present, one in four people (two billion people worldwide) lack safe drinking water. Around 1.4 million people die annually and 74 million will have their lives shortened by diseases related to poor water, sanitation and hygiene. As per the estimates by OECD, global water demand (in water withdrawals) would increase by 55% by 2050.Helauded the paper presenters and appreciated the efforts of the IEI, Jammu Local Centre for organizing this event to create the awareness among masses including the people of Jammu and Kashmir towards depleting water resources.

IEI YOUNG ENGINEERS AWARD 2023 - 2024 Notification

The Institution of Engineers (India) is a multi-disciplinary professional body of engineers with 15 engineering disciplines and over 9,00,000 members in India and abroad. The Institution was established in 1920 and was incorporated by Royal Charter in 1935. It has been in the forefront of engineering profession addressing the socio engineering problems for progress of the country. IEI functions among professional engineers, academicians, research workers to update their professional knowledge through continuous professional development. With its large international linkages and a network of 125 Centres in India and Six Overseas Chapters, the Institution has built up wide reach and large infrastructure to meet its objectives of promoting engineering in all aspects.

With a view to promote the pursuit of excellence in the field of engineering, IEI has instituted 'IEI Young Engineers Award'. The Award consists of a Plaque and a Certificate. The purpose of the Award is to recognize outstanding achievements/contributions made by young engineers in engineering research, excellence in engineering technology development, technology transfer, etc. Any engineer citizen of India not older than 35 years of age as on March 31, 2023 is eligible for the Award. The IEI Young Engineers Award is presented to awardees for all the 15 Engineering Divisions of the IEI during the respective National Conventions. The awardees attending the National Convention will be provided with free accommodation & their travelling expenses (AC-3 Tier train fare by shortest route) will be reimbursed on production of original documents.

The last date of receipt of applications for IEI Young Engineers Award 2023-24 has been extended. The cutoff date will be intimated in the next issue.

The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Centre in collaboration with the Model Institute of Engineering and Technology (MIET), Jammu celebrated the World Engineering Day for Sustainable Development on 4th March 2023 with theme "Engineering Innovation for a more resilient world". The event was attended by Engineers from various Departments, Organizations and Senior Engineers along with Members of the Committee of IEI, Jammu Local Centre.

The day is celebrated worldwide on 4th March every year since 2020 as a UNESCO international day of celebration of Engineers and Engineering.

On this occasion, Er. Sandeep Seth, Chief Engineer, JPDCL, J&K Power Development Department, Jammu was the Chief Guest and Major General (Retd.) S. K. Sharma AVSM, Director MIER Group of Institutions was the Guest of Honour, whereas Prof. (Dr.) Bhawna Sharma, Chairman, IEI Jammu Centre presided over the function. Sh. Sunil Kumar Pachar, Director, Ecolive Ventures Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram was Key Note Speaker in the Seminar.

At the outset, Prof. (Dr.) Bhawna Sharma presented the Welcome Address and introduced the relevance of the day to the audience. She said that there is a greater need for reimagining the cities with innovations in health, agriculture, energy, waste management, industrial and infrastructure development for a more resilient world. Sustainable technology is an umbrella term that describes innovation that considers natural resources and fosters economic and social development.

While speaking on the occasion, Major General (Retd.) S. K. Sharma, AVSM stressed that the earlier slogan of "Perform or Perish" has been replaced by "Innovate or Perish". He said that organizations and engineers who do not devote time on research shall perish. He sought that engineers need to identify problem areas including inefficient processes and find ways to solve them by innovating new or better methods to improve efficiency of the system.
