IEI celebrated World Telecommunication & Information Society Day

The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Centre celebrated World Telecommunication & Information Society Day on 17th May, 2025 & a seminar on the theme "*Gender Equality in Digital Transformation*" was organized. The event was attended by large number of Engineers from various Engineering Departments, Organizations and Senior Engineers along with Members of the Committee of IEI, Jammu Centre.

On this occasion, Mr. Satish Sharma, Hon'ble Minister for IT, Youth Services & Sports, Transport, Science & Technology, Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, ARI & Training, Govt of J&K UT graced the occasion as *Chief Guest*. Mr. Manish Jain, Director Department of Telecommunications, Ministry of Communications, Government of India, Jammu was the *Keynote Speaker* & Er. Anil Verma, FIE Chairman, IEI, Jammu Centre presided over the function.

Er. Anil Verma, Chairman in his *Welcome Address* introduced the importance of this day to the audience. He also emphasized that it is the prime duty of every citizen to make females digital savvy by making them aware about the use of ICTs. Smartphones in present days' World can make a major difference to achieve Gender Equality in this context. He also advocated for issuance of one smartphone each to every Anganwadi Worker so that they can educate all the young girls and women in their respective Anganwadis digitally aware and literate.



Mr. Satish Sharma, Hon'ble Minister, the *Chief Guest* before delivering his address observed two minutes silence along with audience for peace to the departed souls who lost their lives during the recent conflict with the neighboring country.

He also highlighted that digital transformation is going to transform the face of Jammu & Kashmir and in that league, efforts are being made to setup IT parks in cities of Jammu and Srinagar which shall provide employment to youth of J&K and especially 50% of the seats shall be reserved for females. It shall be a leap frog step in the gender inclusiveness and pave way for bridging the digital divide. The initiatives like free e-buses for women shall bring the women from rural areas closer to the main stream and help them to connect with employment opportunities across the length and breadth of Jammu and Kashmir. He further emphasized that the aim of J&K Govt. is to contribute towards sustainable development in our UT & end the years of gender discrimination prevailing in the society.

Mr. Manish Jain, *Keynote Speaker* highlighted the importance of International Telecommunication Union (ITU) in digital transformation and initiatives of Department of Telecom for digital inclusiveness so that digital divide in the country is minimized. The goal of sustainable development is only possible if 50% of population i.e. female also equally create, code and lead our country to progress.

During the seminar Er. Ranjeev Sawhney, MIE; Er. Sachin Tickoo, MIE; Er. Joy Ganjoo, AM Technologist & Er. Anil Kumar, AMIE also presented their papers on the theme.

The Institution of Engineers (India), Jammu Centre celebrated World Environment Day on 5th June, 2025 with the theme *"Beat Plastic Pollution"*. The event was attended by Engineers from various Engineering Departments, Organizations and Senior Engineers along with Members of the Committee of IEI, Jammu Centre.

On this occasion, Dr. Devansh Yadav, IAS, Commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation & Chief Executive Officer, Jammu Smart City Ltd. was the *Chief Guest* while Dr. Pratik Kumar, Assistant Professor, Environmental Engineering, IIT, Jammu was the *Keynote Speaker* & Er. Anil Verma, FIE Chairman, IEI, Jammu Centre presided over the function.

Er. Anil Verma, FIE; Chairman in his *Welcome Address* introduced the day's theme to the audience. He regretted that mankind has become slave to plastic use and to lessen this slavery is an uphill task. He advocated for ban on single use plastic manufacturing as a first step to beat plastic pollution & requested the Govt. of UT of J&K to enforce Non-Biodegradable Garbage Control Act on the same lines as in Himachal Pradesh which will go a long way in reducing the menace of plastic use by the people at large.

Dr. Devansh Yadav, IAS, *Chief Guest* informed that mandatory use of plastic in blacktopping of roads in Jammu will be a reality soon which will help in diminishing the harmful plastic presence in the environment. He also emphasized that no doubt non-recyclable plastic is a challenge for the Govt. and all other stakeholders but still efforts are being made to dispose it off scientifically in the times to come.

Dr. Pratik Kumar, *Keynote Speaker* spoke at length about the plastic pollution and appealed that four major stakeholders i.e. Govt., Academia, Industry and Public should join hands and spread a word to curb the use of plastics of all kinds. He also sensitized the audience about the impact of micro plastics for humankind which though invisible to the naked eye, are creating havoc silently in harming humans by manifestation of many diseases.



During the seminar, Er. P. K. Nanda, FIE; Er. B. L. Rawal, FIE; Er. Joy Ganjoo, AM Technologist, Er. Akash Dusgotra, AMIE & Er. Anil Kumar, AMIE presented their papers. While deliberating on the theme, all the speakers appealed to the general masses for minimising the use of plastic products & refrain themselves from throwing it on the roads & drains outside their homes so that a healthy environment is maintained.
